Care coordinators provide well-informed, positive and empathetic services to families by linking them to supports and services they need.

What is a care coordinator?

A 0-8 care coordinator acts as a centralized access point. The care coordinator links children and their families to internal, external, and community based services and programs.



Duties of a care coordinator

A care coordinator will work with families and assess the situation, as well as connect with providers and partnering programs. They will also identify gaps and barriers to services.

Our care coordination team can help walk you through supports and services that may be available for children 0 to 8 years old.

Services and supports may include:

- ▶ Developmental screenings
- ▶ Home visiting
- ▶ Early intervention
- ▶ Head Start & Early Head Start
- ▶ Maternal & infant mental health
- ▶ WIC & educational resources
